

All About Blanks - White Dishtowel Apron Project



Supplies:

- 1 Blank Dishtowel/Tea Towel
- 2 1/2 - 3 yards of ribbon (1" to 1.5" width works best)
- Extra embellishment leftovers - buttons etc.

Step 1:

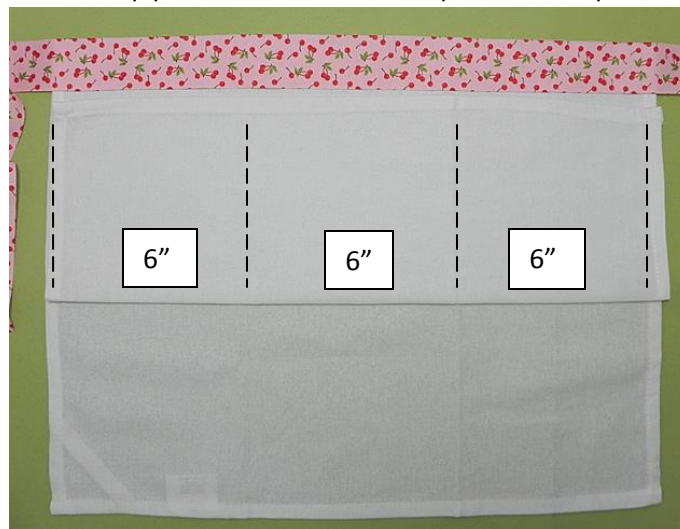
Fold dishtowel in half lengthwise, right sides together.

Step 2:

Find your center point for ribbon and dishtowel and align the ribbon at the top of folded edge. (For our sample we used 1.5" width ribbon). Stitch ribbon to folded top edge.

Step 3:

Fold top layer upwards against bottom edge of ribbon. Pin edges and divide into 3 sections to create 3 pockets. The All About Blanks White Dishtowel is approximately 18" wide, so each of our pockets measure 6". I marked my pocket divisions with a pin at the top and a pin at the bottom.



Step 4:

Sew the edges and through pocket divisions, back stitch at top and bottom for extra strength.

Step 5:

Add any extra embellishment or embroidery. I always have extra pieces laying around from ends of ribbons spools and other projects. These aprons are so much fun to create and make your own little master piece!
